HAPPY NEW YEAR PROGNOSTICATIONS!

2018 brought tremendous growth in our ability to “save babies, change lives, and help churches”.

- * In April Huron Valley Ambulance donated an ambulance which we converted into a mobile ultrasound unit.
- * In July our 35 foot mobile medical clinic built for us by Mobile Specialty Vehicles arrived and was immediately put to work
- * Our med team staffing of volunteers increased from 17 to 31
- * The number of women and babies that we were able to see and help increased from 248 to 598 and we now have babies everywhere!
- * A partnership with the Detroit Health Department has brought an immunization station to every clinic so that our babies, their siblings, and our moms receive the immunizations they need.
- * We presented at OB/GYN Grand Rounds at the U of M and to the OB residents and leadership team of the DMC including their CEO
- * We began a pastoral internship program that brings a 4th year pre-sem student from CUAA on staff and we began an internship program with CUAA nursing students supervised by our Clinical Coordinator.

These are just some of the highlights, but here are some things that I see happening in 2019:

- * Partnerships with two local hospital organizations that will send their physicians and residents to work and learn about relationship based health care at the Luke Project expanding our ability to care for our moms and babies.
- * Articles on The Luke Project will appear in national publications like The American Journal of Public Health.
- * Either an expansion to a 2nd site OR addition of clinic days at the current site.
- * **WE WILL SAVE SOME BABIES WHO WOULD NOT HAVE LIVED IF WE WEREN'T HERE, CHANGE SOME LIVES THROUGH THE POWER OF LOVE, AND HELP SOME CHURCHES REACH MORE PEOPLE FOR CHRIST!**
