PREPPING FOR TELEMEDICINE IN LIGHT OF COVID-19



Because of your overwhelming response to our appeal we have begun distributing Mom Bags to our patients who qualify for telemedicine visits. Besides some goodies each bag contains a fetal doppler, a digital BP machine, and a scale and measure so that when we make a remote visit we will have the info the provider needs on hand. We began distributing at clinic on 4/2 and delivered 7 bags with our ambulance on 4/11

In order to address the need for telemedicine in light of the COVID-19 pandemic AND to expand our ability to care for the vulnerable moms we serve through our mobile antenatal testing program a Lumify C5-2 Bundle with REACT platform (see you tube video above) and 2 Samsung Galaxy Tablets (S6 10.5" 128GB WiFi) for our Family Medicine and Maternal Fetal Medicine staff are on the way. This equipment will enable our staff to see ultrasound in real time remotely as they are being per-
