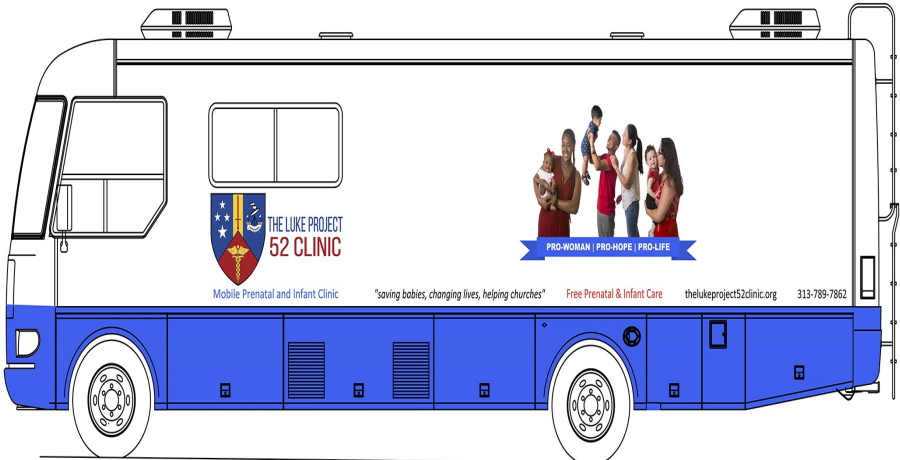

WE ARE MOBILE



Our 35' Mobile Medical Clinic from Mobile Specialty Vehicles arrives in one week on 6/20/2018. Stocking day is Saturday, June 23 at 200 Barker Road in Whitmore Lake and the unit will be on display at the Michigan District Convention held on the campus of Concordia University in Ann Arbor from 4 pm Sunday June 24 through noon on Tuesday June 26. Unit will have 2 exam rooms, lab, and pharmacy. Come see!



Our mobile antenatal testing unit is now ready and we will begin using it at clinic on June 21. We have had 75 fetal anatomy and fetal growth scans that we have had to refer with considerable compliance issues since January 1. In addition we have been doing 4-6 non stress tests per month in addition to 6 dating scans per clinic. We are hopeful that our new unit will enable us to achieve a much higher compliance rate on these crucial scans. We will need another ultrasound machine and another tech to make this happen.
