## LUKE STANDS IN THE GAP DURING COVID-19

Churches closed for in-person worship. Restaurants shut down. But at-risk Moms continued to need care and babies still needed saving so the staff at The Luke Project 52 Clinic pressed on.

In Ezekiel 22:29-30a it says *"The people of the land...oppress the poor and needy and mistreat the alien, denying them justice. I looked for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land..."*

In this passage no one was found who would do this. The women of The Luke Project 52 Clinic staff chose to stand in the gap during this pandemic for our Moms and babies.
