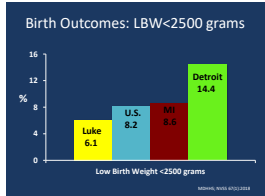
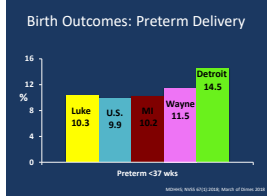
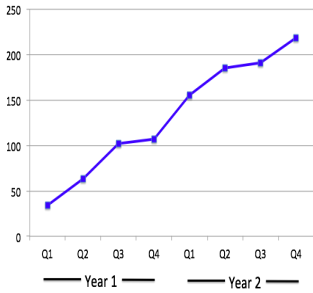

As you can see from the information above, we have been extremely blessed by your generosity. We are making a difference in the lives of the Moms that your gifts help us to serve. We could not have done this without you, and we cannot take the next steps without your continued support. The number of moms we serve has increased 10 fold since we began. Our mobile clinic (purchased in July for \$132,000) and ambulance (purchased/donated in April for \$1500) have enabled us to increase our exam room space by 60%. We have had over 10,000 hours of volunteer time donated. Benjamin's closet has provided baby supplies, equipment, and clothing to over 200 moms and we have hosted almost 80 baby showers.

If we are going to take The Luke Clinic to another location in 2019-20 (think Flint, or Pontiac, or the east side of Detroit), we will need to transition to a partial paid staff from our current all volunteer staff. That will increase our budget dramatically. We are exploring partnerships with the U of M, Beaumont, and DMC hospitals that could lessen the impact of those staff addition costs, but there will still be increases so we cannot move forward without your support.
